- Perform all emergency service on equipment as needed.

- Ability to work cooperatively with other staff and to effectively supervise junior personnel.
- Must be physically capable of performing the duties of the position in all types of conditions both indoors and outdoors.

- Experience with installation of duct work and HRV systems.
