### **PURPOSE OF POSITION**

This position entails standard lifeguarding and instructing duties at Brandon's Community Sportsplex. Successful incumbents will be required to provide instruction in the many pool programs offered at the facility. Lifeguard/Instructors are responsible for the general maintenance, care, and conditions of the pool area. Incumbents will work a variety of shifts during days, evenings, and weekends which may include split shifts.

- Lifesaving Society National Lifeguard award;
- Swim for Life and or Lifesaving Instructor.

### **PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS & EXPERIENCE**

- Swim for Life and or Lifesaving Trainer;
- National Lifeguard Instructor/Examiner;
- Lifesaving Society or Red Cross First Aid Instructor certificate.
