The Manitoba Métis Federation (MMF) is the democratically elected National Government of the Red River Métis, also known as the Manitoba Métis. The Red River Métis are a distinct Indigenous Nation and People, and Canada's Negotiating Partners in Confederation and the Founders of the Province of Manitoba.

The MMF seeks to fill **one full-time Agriculture Specialist** position within our **Energy, Infrastructure, and Resource Management Department (EIRM)** located at 200 Main Street in **Winnipeg, MB**. The Agriculture Specialist will be primarily responsible for advising Red River Métis agricultural producers on the implementation of new on-farm beneficial management practices (BMPs). This position will be responsible for ensuring all project deliverables including BMPs implementation is achieved.

Job Duties/Competencies:

- Develop and oversee approved projects;
- Build relationships and communicate with MMF Citizens to expand Agriculture Programs;
- Coordinate work associated with the facilitation of meetings, community workshops, teleconferences, etc.;
- Prepare reports, briefings, and letters, for review by the Director;
- Facilitate Citizen involvement in project planning;
- Work collaboratively with industry, government, and non-government relationships;
- Provide any necessary documentation in relation to meetings, including follow up from corresponding departments;
- Research and review all relevant documents, policy, legislation, etc;
- Research and develop surveys and interview questions on climate concerns.

Skills and Qualifications:

- Hold or be eligible for membership in the Manitoba Institute of Agrologists with a Professional Agrologist
 designation, and the ability to obtain the designation if successful for this position;
- Hold a valid Certified Crop Advisor certification (if ineligible for a P.Ag. designation);
- Completion of post-secondary education related to Agriculture is an asset;
- Experience working in or knowledge of the field of Agriculture is a strong asset;
- Strong communication, organizational, and time management skills;
- Experience working with boards and/or committees is preferred;
- Experience working for a not-for-profit organization and Indigenous community is an asset;
- Knowledge of Red River Métis culture, MMF programs and services is a definite asset; and,
- Ability to frequently travel, valid Manitoba Driver's license with access to a reliable vehicle.
