PURPOSE OF POSITION

Activities could include but are not limited to swimming, skating, team sports, arts & crafts, music & dance, cultural education, outdoor exploring, etc.

- Plan, supervise and participate in program activities under the direction of the Recreation Program Assistant;
- Provide leadership and direction to the participants and show enthusiasm;
- Provide a safe, cooperative and enjoyable environment for program participants;
- Adjust program activities to accommodate a variety of group sizes, interests and participant skill levels;
- Implement the evaluation plan and submit a final report on the program;
- Ensure public health guidelines are adhered to at all times;
- Perform other duties as assigned or required.
