The Survey Crew Chief leads the survey crew which conducts field surveys, inspections or technical investigations of topography, soils, drainage and water supply systems, road and highway systems, buildings, and structures to provide data for engineering projects related to municipal maintenance, construction and planning projects required for the safe and efficient construction of the City's underground utilities and roadways. This successful candidate will need the ability to work evenings and weekends as required.
