- Hold or obtain within eighteen (18) months of appointment, Level 1 Certification in Water Distribution and Wastewater Collection;
- Hold or obtain within thirty-six (36) months of appointment Level 2 Certification in Water Distribution and Wastewater Collection;
- Required to obtain all certifications required by provincial regulations;
- Minimum two (2) years' experience operating equipment, such as sewer jet, front end loader, rubber tire or track excavator, CCTV van, tandem, tractor trailer combination low bed or end dump, etc.;
