Your minimum 2-5 years' experience and knowledge of engineering design, drafting, construction supervision, contract management, surveying and water management make you the ideal candidate for this position, which is located in Yorkton, Saskatchewan.

- Knowledge of engineering design, hydrology and construction supervision involving heavy equipment.

- Awareness of provincial Occupational Health and Safety practices; knowledge of the provincial Water Acts, Dam Safety Regulations and the approvals process would be considered an asset.

- Experience with operating ATVs.
- Knowledge and understanding of prairie agriculture would be definite asset.
