Reporting to the Planner, the Journeyman Carpenter is responsible for layout, installation, repairing, finishing, and maintaining various structures, fixtures, and buildings. Other duties will include designing, cutting, and measuring materials according to a client's requirements.

The incumbent will also work in cooperation with other trades and labourers to ensure that all specifications, legislation and policies are met, and to ensure efficient completion of any project. This is a permanent, full-time position on a rotation schedule. This position may be required to travel to various communities in Nunavut.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Perform all aspects of carpentry for new construction or renovation work in accordance with work orders, plans and specifications
- Ability to read and interpret blueprints
- Conduct repair work and installation of doors, windows, drywall, cabinets, stairs, and other fixtures as required
- Ability to assess the quality of woodwork and materials
- Ability to operate tools, machines, and other equipment
- Compliance with local building codes, and health and safety regulations
- Completion of work order forms, detailing work performed and materials used
- Supervision/training of apprentices as required
- Oversee skilled labourers that are assigned to assist with any project work
- Perform tasks in accordance to health and safety standards
- Be on call-out team to handle emergencies
- Travel to other various communities in Nunavut when needed
- Other duties as required and assigned
