The position provides a hands-on opportunity to learn about native habitat, participate in ecological restoration and make a positive contribution to Winnipeg's riparian forests.

Duties:

The successful candidate will work on reforestation, trail enhancement, monitoring, and invasive species management along the Assiniboine River's riparian forest. Some of the project activities include:

- Planting trees and shrubs
- Invasive species removal and monitoring (European buckthorn, in particular)
- Assisting with vegetation sampling
- Maintenance of trails and promotion of sustainable recreation

Qualifications:

- Ability to work as part of a team
- A positive attitude with a desire to work outdoors and get your hands dirty
- Able to commit to the entire length of the position
- A student interested in an environmental career
- An interest in native plants and wildlife in the Winnipeg area
