POSITION SUMMARY: The Housing Manager shall be responsible for the daily operations of the Sioux Valley Housing Authority. They shall enforce and adhere to the Sioux Valley Housing Authority Policy for all housing units and provide assistance to Sioux Valley Housing Authority needs and responsibilities.
