As a landscape technician your responsibilities entail; The job is physically demanding, strenuous and can be monotonous at times. Our work schedule is typically Monday to Friday with an average of 100hr pay periods. We pay OT after 100 hrs. We ask that you come to work willing and ready each and every day and work to the best of your ability.
