## Conservation Technician (Summer Student Position) Brandon, MB

### The Opportunity

Ducks Unlimited Canada (DUC), a leader Canadian habitat conservation, is seeking a highly motivated student to fill the summer Conservation Technician position in Brandon, Manitoba.

### Duties may include:

Day-to-day duties may include overseeing project signage installation and coordinating utility locates, assisting with chemical and mechanical weed control on DUC's upland projects, assisting staff with annual monitoring of projects, project field inspections, in-field GPS mapping of habitat on projects, and general shop maintenance. You will be planning field activities within a team environment.

This position, which will be based from our office in Brandon, Manitoba, involves physical work, heavy lifting and outdoor work in all weather conditions. Our ideal candidate will be able to take direction and execute tasks in a safe and efficient manner without direct supervision.

### Additional Details

- Available for work between mid-May and late-August (approximately 15 -17 weeks)
- Full-time student between the ages of 17 and 30
- The position is based on funding where the successful candidate must be a full-time student in the previous academic year and intend to return to school on a full-time basis in the next academic year

### Requirements

- Navigating with landowner maps (legal descriptions)
- GIS capabilities, familiar with GPS units
- Basic knowledge of ArcMap suite of programs would be considered an asset
- Basic knowledge of Microsoft Excel and Word
- Valid driver's license; some travel within Southern MB
- Ability to work flexible hours, and a strong work ethic
- Experience operating ATVs and/or farm equipment, and towing trailers is considered an asset
- Comfortable working as part of a team or independently
- Must have a passion for conservation, the environment and the outdoors.
- The successful candidate will be required to submit proof of COVID-19 Vaccination
