In addition to the production and retail of seed to commercial producers, this seed farm has developed a unique business segment focusing on early-generation seed increase for breeding institutions, seed companies and other pedigreed seed producers.

We are seeking a motivated individual with a keen interest in crop production and the ability to work as an integral part of our team in our detailed systems of pedigreed seed production, processing, and distribution. While previous experience in seed production or processing is an asset, the willingness to learn and an ability to manage systems and offer a range of skills from handson equipment operation to process documentation, are of most importance. Job duties could include:
