- Ensure all work is done in compliance with applicable regulations particularly with regards to electrical work and pressure piping.

- Provide periodic, meaningful feedback to staff through performance evaluations and job observations.
- Participate in mill operational meetings looking to eliminate pain points and find opportunities for continuous improvement.
- Be willing and able to be on-call on a regular basis support your team.
