Responsibilities

1. Responsible for:

- Weeding, watering, cleaning, and general maintenance of the grounds in and around the Riverbank Discovery Centre as well as the grounds to the north, the area directly south of the building, along the Arbour Trail, Native Grass Trail, trails around the pond, Festival Park, picnic shelters, Sharing Circle, and at the Labyrinth of Peace.
- Checking and replacing garbage bins on a daily basis as well as replacing bags and cleaning out garbage bin liners. Setting out bins every Monday, per the Tuesday morning garbage pick-up schedule.
- Power wash and/or sweep the picnic gazebo, patio, garbage bin liners, and entrances as required.
- Replacing the bird seed in the bird feeders on a weekly or twice weekly basis; dependent on usage.
- Assisting the Interpreter as time permits in the months of July and August in preparing for outdoor programs.
