- Must obtain a RAP Restricted Area Pass through the Brandon Municipal Airport and an AVOP (airside vehicle operators pass) issued by the airport within one (1) month of hire.

- Minimum of two (2) years experience operating equipment grader/loader;
- Previous airport experience.
