Required Qualifications


- Journeyman Red Seal Refrigeration HVAC Technician. •
- A minimum of Manitoba Gas Fitter's 'B' License.
- A minimum of Limited Electrical Class M License. •
- MOPIA Certification. •
- A minimum of five (5) years experience in servicing, installing, troubleshooting refrigeration, heating • and air conditioning systems and components (including, but not limited to: chillers, boilers, air handing units, fan coils, heat pumps, gas equipment, unit heaters, air makeups, pumps, air dryers, air compressors as well as packaged air conditioning systems).
- A minimum of five (5) years experience with building automation systems. •
- A minimum of five (5) years experience in control systems such as Direct Digital Controls, Programmable Logic Controller (PLC), Variable Frequency Drives, Pneumatic devices and systems including troubleshooting and performing on-board diagnostics tests of electronic and solid-state devices.
- A minimum of five (5) years experience in commercial building heating and cooling systems. •
- Demonstrated ability to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing. •
- Strong interpersonal skills for dealing with other trades and Division employees. •
- Ability to work with minimal supervision and under own initiative.
- Class 5 Driver's Licence.
